

COLUMBIA SHUSWAP REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 5001

A bylaw to establish and operate the extended service of a Sterile Insect Release Service for the Columbia Shuswap Regional District.

WHEREAS Section 789 of the Municipal Act provides for the establishment and operation of extended services within a regional district;

AND WHEREAS Section 283 of the Municipalities Enabling and Validating Act, R.S.B.C. 1960 provides for the establishment of the Okanagan-Kootenay Sterile Insect Release Board for the purpose of providing a Sterile Insect Release Service;

AND WHEREAS the Sterile Insect Release Service is designed to control destructive insect pests by means of a program that includes the release of sterile insects;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Districts of Okanagan-Similkameen, Central Okanagan, North Okanagan, Columbia Shuswap and Central Kootenay shall participate and share in the service;

AND WHEREAS the Okanagan Kootenay Sterile Insect Release Board shall act as agent for the participating regional districts for the provision of the service;

AND WHEREAS the assent of the electors of the District of Salmon Arm and of the participating area of Electoral Area 'D' has been waived and consent has been given pursuant to the authority of Section 283(3) of the Municipalities Enabling and Validating Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Columbia Shuswap Regional District, in open meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

Service and Service Area

1. Pursuant to Section 283(2) of the Municipalities Enabling and Validating Act, the Columbia Shuswap Regional District, in conjunction with the Okanagan-Similkameen, Central Okanagan, North Okanagan, and Central Kootenay Regional Districts, hereby establishes the Okanagan-Kootenay Sterile Insect Release Board (SIR Board) which, as agent for the participating regional districts, will provide the sterile insect release service.
2. The SIR Board will be comprised of one member appointed annually by each participating regional district from its elected directors. The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, the Minister of Agriculture Canada and the British Columbia Fruit Growers' Association may each appoint one person as a nonvoting member of the SIR Board.

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3. The SIR Board shall not, without the approval of the participating regional districts,
- a) borrow money, or
 - b) incur liabilities.

Participating Areas

4. The participating areas within the Columbia Shuswap Regional District are the District of Salmon Arm and a portion of Electoral Area 'D' as outlined on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

Cost

5. The participating regional districts shall borrow necessary funds and incur debt to implement and operate the extended service of the Sterile Insect Release Service.
6. The long-term debt incurred by the Regional District for this function shall not exceed in the aggregate the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000), and apportioned pursuant to Section 8 herein.

Cost Recovery and Limit

7. The annual operating and debt servicing costs shall be recovered in the following manner:
- a) Firstly, the Columbia Shuswap Regional District and all other participating regional districts shall levy a parcel tax imposed in accordance with the Municipal Act and Section 283 of the Municipalities Enabling and Validating Act and accompanying regulations.
 - b) Secondly, the amount of the annual operating and debt servicing costs that are apportioned to the Columbia Shuswap Regional District in accordance with Section 8 shall be raised by a property value tax on land only. The property value tax shall not exceed 34 cents per \$1,000 of the net taxable value for land only within the participating areas for Regional Hospital District purposes.

Cost Apportionment

8. The SIR Board shall apportion net annual operating and debt servicing costs among participating regional districts on the basis of converted land value assessment within the participating areas for the current year for Regional Hospital District purposes. Net annual operating and debt servicing costs means total costs net of or after the amounts raised by all participating regional districts through the parcel tax noted in Section 7. a) and any other revenue.

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- 9. The Columbia Shuswap Regional District shall apportion its share of the net annual operating and debt servicing costs among the participating areas on the basis of converted land value assessment within the participating areas for the current year for Regional Hospital District purposes.
- 10. This bylaw may be cited as the "Columbia Shuswap Regional District Sterile Insect Release Extended Service Establishment Bylaw No. 5001."


