About Us

We are an environmentally-friendly control Program for one of the biggest pests of apple and pear trees— the codling moth. Since the start of the Program, more than 20 years ago, the amount of pesticides used in the region against codling moth has dropped by 96%. Our Program breeds and sterilizes codling moths at our state-of-the-art facility in Osoyoos, and we release them into orchards where they mate with wild moths to prevent the population from reproducing. Our Program also provides trapping/monitoring/enforcement services for orchardists, education, and a chance to make a difference for our farmers and the environment.

About The Position

Are you a detail-oriented individual who's looking to make a difference in their community? Are you good with numbers, fast and accurate with data entry, and a whiz with Microsoft excel? If you are baking, do you follow the recipe with absolute precision?

If so, then we have an exciting opportunity at our state-of the art facility in Osoyoos. This one-year term position will help cover the absence of our valued team members in the Quality Control lab. The *Lab and Facility Assistant* will work primarily with our Quality Control Technician and report directly to the Facility Manager. They will perform standard lab practices (training will be provided). They must be able to enter data quickly and accurately and generate basic graphs and reports in excel. They will ensure all procedures are completed in a safe and professional manner and they will also assist with rearing or cleaning tasks and processes related to codling moth sales and shipping. This is a full-time, term position, with full extended health/dental benefits and an excellent RRSP-matching plan.

Duties Include:

- Data collection and data entry
- Some data analysis
- Measure and monitor insect health and fitness
- Executing standard lab tests including air quality, pH, and facility sanitation checks
- Assist with sales requests of insects, egg sheets, and assorted materials
- Assist with insect rearing or facility cleaning as required (moderate lifting required, up to 25 lbs)
- Other duties as required
