Position Overview

The Urban Monitor is responsible for carrying out daily urban inspections to various residential properties and answers directly to the Urban Supervisor. The Urban Monitor will interact with local homeowners and the general public to communicate program information, policies, and best care procedures in a professional and effective manner to prevent and manage codling moth infestations.

Responsibilities/Accountabilities

Responsibilities:

1. Establish and maintain effective relationships with internal and external stakeholders
2. Conduct inspections of residential properties for codling moth infestation and identify fruit damage
3. Communicate best-care practices to host tree owners, including tree removal negotiations
4. Communicate all concerns to Supervisor
5. Identify codling moth host trees in urban areas
6. Carry out codling moth control bylaw enforcement as appropriate in cases of non-compliance, as directed by the Urban Supervisor
7. Complete other duties as assigned by the Urban Supervisor
